4. Other Discussions:

Bidders are made to understand the documents they need to submit as discussed in the provided checklist. Bidders are reminded to sign all pages of the triplicate copies and requested to bring one flashdrive containing the e-copies of their submitted eligibility, technical and financial requirements. It was mentioned that Section VI (Schedule of Requirements) and Section VII. (Technical Specifications) of the Bidding Documents must be signed by the bidder’s authorized representative and both must be included in the first envelope.

The BAC instructed the bidder to submit one original copy and three (3) photocopies of the documents contained in envelope 1 and 2. It was also mentioned that the BAC will recommend to the College President to request the exception of the project in the election ban to award the contract immediately once the BAC issued its award recommendation through a resolution.

5. Notice to the Bidders

Through this Bid Bulletin, the BAC would like to inform the bidders that the cost of administrative cost is hereby reduced from 4% to 1%. The submission and opening of bids are moved to March 17, 2025.
